TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and, particularly, to the electors of the Crystal Lakes Fire Protection District of Larimer County, Colorado.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held on the 8th day of May, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At that time, 2 directors will be elected to serve 4-year terms and 1 director will be elected to serve a 2-year term. Eligible electors of the Crystal Lakes Fire Protection District interested in serving on the board of directors may obtain a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form from the District Designated Election Official (DEO):

The Office of the DEO is open on: Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. If the DEO determines that a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form is not sufficient, the eligible elector who submitted the form may amend the form once, at any time, prior to 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2,, 2012. The deadline to submit a Self-Nomination and Acceptance is close of business on Friday, March 2, 2012 (not less than 67 days before the election). Earlier submittal is encouraged as the deadline will not permit curing an insufficient form. Affidavit of Intent To Be A Write-In-Candidate forms must be submitted to the office of the Designated Election official by the close of business on Monday, March 5, 2012 (the sixty-fourth day before the election).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, an application for an absentee (mail-in) ballot shall be filed with the Designated Election official no later than the close of business on Friday, May 4, 2012, except that, if the applicant wishes to receive the mail-in ballot by mail, the application shall be filed no later than the close of business on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.

PROCEDURAL INSTRUCTION: For Regular Elections, the "Call for Nominations" is to be published no more than 90 days (2/9/12) before election nor less than 75 days (2/23/12) before the election, per C.R.S. 32-1-804.1. In addition, C.R.S. 1-1-104(34) defines 'publication' as *printing one time, in a newspaper of general circulation in the [special district if there is such a newspaper, and if not, then in a newspaper in the county in which the special district is located.* Districts in more than one county should review the complete definition.
